19th June, 2009 - "Berlin Semantic Web Day" at Freie Universität Berlin Topic of the Berlin Semantic Web Day is Semantic Business Process Management (SBPM) which is the combination of Corporate Semantic Web technologies, such as rules, events and ontologies, with BPM. This unique combination promises enhanced automation in discovery, configuration and composition of appropriate process components, information objects, and services, as well as automated mediation between different heterogeneous interfaces and abstraction levels, targeted complex queries on the process space and flow, and in general much more agile business process management.
